SECRET DESIGNS ON THE \$1 BILL

Have you ever really taken a close look at your money? Here are some interesting designs on the \$1 bill and how they tie to the original 13 colonies. You might need a magnifying glass!

- 2. 13 steps on the pyramid.
- 3. 13 vertical bars on the shield.
- 4. 13 horizontal stripes on the top of the shield.
- 5. 13 stars above the eagle.
- 6. 13 leaves and 13 berries on the olive branch in one of the eagle's talons, and in its other there are 13 arrows.
